

WebAssign and Eduspace
Everyone is expected to submit on-line WebAssign homework.

Please go to the WebAssign home page: <http://www.webassign.net>

Log in if you have not already done so with the access code that was provided you in lab. There are five assignments posted. Username = last name; Password = DVC id #(no leading zeroes).

The first assignment is a general introduction to WebAssign with various types of questions from several different disciplines. Please complete the assignment, but do not worry about the correctness of your answers. The intro will not be included in your homework grade, but introduce you to the process.

Results from the remaining four assignments: Chapter 1 – Chapter 4 will be incorporated into your homework grade..

The homework assignments have completion deadlines that are set just prior to a quiz or an exam. Submissions will not be accepted after the deadlines pass. Each chapter has different types of questions, different numbers of questions and different values for the respective questions. In order to receive full credit for the homework assignment, you must score 50% or higher based on the total points possible for the chapter questions.

The questions include the Zumdahl textbook's end of chapter problems, Active learning questions, additional text questions, additional exercises, and challenge problems. You are not expected to master all of them. Mastering 50% is a nominally acceptable level of performance, but the higher that you score above this level, the better that you will perform on quizzes and exams.

Eduspace is not required for on-line homework. Eduspace provides a broad collection of resources and study aides to assist you. No grades will come directly from Eduspace.

To use Eduspace you will need a passkey. It comes with the purchase of a new textbook. If you purchased a used book, to use Eduspace you will need to buy a passkey form either the DVC bookstore or from the publisher (\$28.36 online):

5. ACE Practice Tests Take ACE Practice Tests (as often as you like) and get immediate feedback on whether or not you understand key concepts.
